Dear Sewage Enforcement Officer,

We hope this email finds all of you well during this COVID-19 pandemic emergency. We are reaching out to you to inform you of the following:

- As you are all aware, the end of the Sewage Enforcement Officer (SEO) certification cycle is June 30, 2020. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic emergency, including company closures, social distancing, and the uncertainty of how events will evolve in the future, the Department of Environmental Protection is extending the renewal date and the SEO Continuing Education requirement, currently required by June 30, 2020, to September 30, 2020. If any of your municipalities need proof of this extension, they can contact us or visit the SEO webpage at <u>https://www.dep.pa.gov/Business/Water/CleanWater/WastewaterMgmt/Act537/Pages/Sewag</u> <u>eEnforcementOfficers.aspx</u>. Please note that from now on your SEO certification cycle will be October 1 through September 30 of even numbered years.
