PA Clean Water Tool

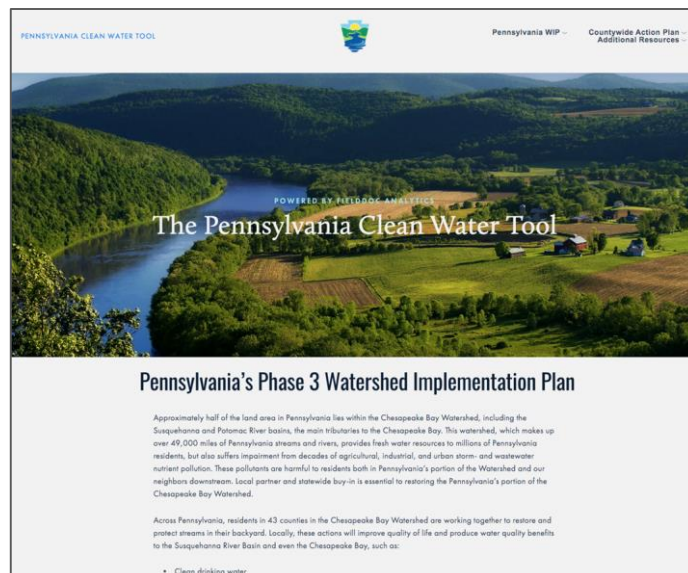

The Pennsylvania Clean Water Tool provides the general public a communication and data management tool that transparently displays progress toward implementation of the Pennsylvania Phase 3 Watershed Implementation Plan (WIP) and the respective Countywide Action Plans (CAPs). This tool acts as the central hub of information for all data management related tools. Individual county pages allow for annual CAP reporting. This tool will stay up to date for all data management related activities.

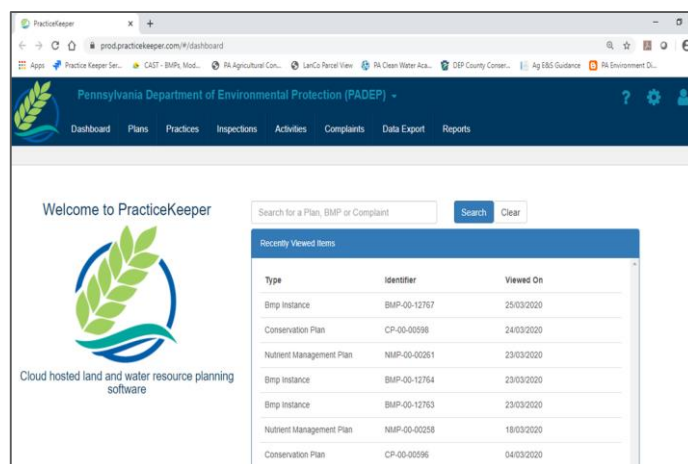

PracticeKeeper streamlines agriculture Best Management Practice (BMP) tracking for state agencies and conservation districts. This solution also allows certified users to record data easily and run reports on conservation plans, nutrient management, erosion and sediment control, watershed plans, and more. A new BMP module allows for external partners outside of state agencies and conservation districts to enter agricultural or forestry related BMPs.

Main Users: State Conservation Commission (SCC), Department of Conservation & Natural Resources (DCNR), DEP, Conservation Districts, External Partners

User Restrictions: Licensed platform for certified users

FieldDoc is a data management and reporting tool designed to assist with reporting and tracking of the Pennsylvania Phase 3 WIP and Countywide Action Plans (CAPs). Progress toward achieving each of the best management practice (BMP) goals identified in each respective CAP can be transparently tracked on its county page. FieldDoc will be an integrated tool that displays aggregated Hydrologic Unit Code (HUC) 12 data for tracking progress, from all state and federally reported data for each county. County Coordinators and those designated by the County Coordinator can report “unreported” BMPs for credit toward CAP goals.

ADAPTED CHESAPEAKE NUTRIENT AND SEDIMENT LOAD REDUCTION MODEL

The following metric values were generated using data and algorithms supplied by the Adapted Chesapeake Nutrient and Sediment Load Reduction Model model. You can find more information about this model [here](#).

	Estimated value
Pounds of total suspended solids reduced	2,216.61 pounds per year
Pounds of total nitrogen reduced	17.77 pounds per year
Pounds of total phosphorus reduced	2.09 pounds per year

- Main Users:** County Coordinators, County Planning Commissions, Conservation Districts, Municipalities, Qualified Environmental Professionals
- Source Data:** FieldDoc, integration of all reported Best Management Practices
- User Restrictions:** Restricted county access

FieldDoc will be a tool to report “unreported” Best Management Practices, not documented through other reporting systems. Guidance on what practices should be entered in FieldDoc can be found in the FieldDoc User Guide.
